



## 2010 Entry Criteria

1. Nominees must be aged 18 – 35 years and should not turn 36 years before 31 December 2010.
2. Works must be completed in the 12 month period prior to 31 May 2010.
3. Emerging Western Australian artists (preferably graduates of art institutions and/or affiliated to galleries), dedicated to pursuing art as a career, whose works are valued at under \$5,000 per artwork.
4. Artwork selected to showcase contemporary art including painting and photography. The subject matter must be deemed suitable by curator for viewing in a public space. This decision will be final.
5. Nominees are encouraged to submit two works each in keeping with size and weight restrictions (see Terms & Conditions).
6. Select YAWA exhibits may feature in the Artitude Exhibition. These will be selected by the Artitude curator whose decision is final.
7. Nominees must consent to the nomination and make themselves available (without fees) for publicity purposes as required, at any time during the period prior to the YAWA exhibition and after the awards are announced on 18 May 2010. Nominees and artists must also consent to have images of their works used for publicity purposes.
8. An award can be withdrawn or work not exhibited if a recipient's character is called into question. We reserve the right to withdraw an award or exhibit if further information or the recipient's conduct does, or has the potential to, bring YAWA, Artitude, Telethon Speech & Hearing or Burswood Entertainment Complex into disrepute.
9. The curator reserves the right to select the artworks displayed at YAWA (and Artitude). This decision will be final and no written or verbal explanation is mandatory.
